The Manhattan Beach Police Department is currently accepting applications for the Winter 2012 Community Police Academy Class. The Academy is a ten-week program that is designed to educate residents and local citizens on the various aspects of law enforcement.

The first session will take place on Thursday, January 19, 2012 at 6:00-9:00 P.M. in the MBPD Community Room . Classes will continue weekly and will culminate on March 22nd with a graduation ceremony. Each session will highlight select divisions within the Police Department, to include: Patrol, K-9, Traffic, SWAT, CSI and more!! Participants will also tour the Manhattan Beach Police Department and Jail, the state-of-the-art 911 Center and go on a 4-hour ride along with a Manhattan Beach Police Officer.

To participate, an Academy application (*on reverse side*) must be submitted for review to determine suitability for the program and applicants must meet the following criteria: be at least 18 years old, reside/work within the City of Manhattan Beach, not have felony convictions, not be wanted for any crime and submit to a limited background check (to include: warrants & criminal history).
