Students are asked to make reading a priority every day and we are asking families to continue to encourage reading. Even if a student is a beginning reader, the time parents spend reading to their sons and daughters counts! We want all students to be involved and excited about reading. Students will log their home reading minutes on their R.O.C.K. Reading Log, located on back of this page.

On Friday, March 2nd, at 1:30, we will celebrate the completion of the R.O.C.K. Read-A-thon with school-wide reading on the upper playground. Students may wear pajamas and bring their favorite book to read to themselves or a friend.

Important dates:

February 1st - Students begin logging their minutes read each day.

February 6th - Students bring their reading logs to school so their teachers may record their reading minutes. Reading logs will be returned to students.

February 13th - Students bring their reading logs to school so their teachers may record their reading minutes. Reading logs will be returned to students.

February 20th - February 24th - There is no school this week, but keep reading! These minutes count toward your goal.

February 27th - Students turn in their reading logs with their total reading time. We need student logs by this date so we can count the school-wide reading minutes.

February 29th - Pajamarama, 6:30 pm - 7:30 pm, Come to Pacific for your bedtime story! All Panthers are welcome to come to Pacific in their pajamas to hear from some celebrity readers and enjoy a bedtime snack.
